



## Individual Fellowship Applications Marie Skłodowska-Curie - H2020 ICS-ULisboa – Host Institution

In the framework of the **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships (IF)** – programme promoted by H2020, the Instituto de Ciências Sociais [Institute of Social Sciences] of the Universidade de Lisboa (Portugal) is accepting applications from social scientists in the areas of social and cultural anthropology, political science, economics, human geography, history, social psychology and sociology, whose work plans can be developed within the ICS's Research Agenda established for 2015-2020 – **Changing Societies: Legacies and Challenges**, and the research and thematic areas of ICS's Research Groups.

The Institute is a vibrant research centre dedicated to addressing important social issues in an interdisciplinary context and is composed of a body of researchers from many different areas of the social sciences as well as from various countries. It was evaluated in 2014 as 'Institution of Excellence' by international ESF panels and offers excellent working conditions, financial support for research and international networks. The Institute is located in Lisbon, a beautiful and historical city offering a rich array of cultural and social activities.

Office space will be provided along with computer, email and internet access as well as free access to the ICS's library facilities.

The selection process at ICS-ULisboa, as host institution (beneficiary), is designed to evaluate applications submitted within the framework of the following **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions - Individual Fellowships (IF)**:

**EF** – European Fellowships

**GF** – Global Fellowships

**Applications** must be accompanied by the following documents:

- A detailed curriculum vitae;
- A covering letter describing the candidate's current research interests;
- One copy of each of two relevant publications;
- A research proposal (of a maximum of 1500 words);
- Two letters of recommendation written by social scientists. At least one of them must be from a non-Portuguese institution;
- Indication of the ICS-ULisboa researcher who will be responsible for supervising the candidate's work plan.

**Notification of decision on hosting candidates: 5 September 2016**, via email.

Marie Skłodowska-Curie – Individual Fellowships are available for experienced researchers, who must have, at the date of the call deadline, a doctoral degree or at least four years of full time equivalent research experience.
